# Spotlight on an Elite Sports Student - Vanesa Cimermanova – Year 10

In 2022 Vanesa Cimermanova was selected for the National Age Group Development Programme 2022. As a result of this, she has been to many competitions/ meets but her best result has come from the Summer Nationals this year.

Firstly, Vanesa attended to British Summer Nationals from the 22 July - 28 July 2023 competing in two events: 50m and 100m backstroke. She reached the finals in both events winning a bronze medal in 100m and taking the gold medal in the 50m, with a time of 30.12secs. At the same competition, Vanesa competed as a member of two relay teams: 4x200m freestyle relay and the 4x100m medley relay.

She then went on to compete in English Summer Nationals from the 2 August - 5 August 2023 competing in 50m freestyle and 200m backstroke. This time she reached the finals in the 200m backstroke and won the gold medal in a winning time of 2.22.21.

As a result of her amazing performances, Vanesa has been selected for the Swim England National Youth Programme 23/24 and is working towards making the GB team, qualifying for European Juniors for the 100m backstroke. **Congratulations to Vanesa. We are so proud of you!**
