



THE PROCESS OF DECIDING ON YOUR GRADE



Your subject teachers will initially determine the grades.



The grades will be reviewed by the Head of Faculty and then by SLT, so grades are determined consistently.



The examination boards will sample evidence to make sure it meets their requirements.



The professional judgement of teachers will only be based on what you have been taught.

THE EVIDENCE

Your teachers will use a range of evidence from across the course of study to make their decision.

This evidence may include pieces of work that have already been completed and further assessments that will be set this term.

Where possible, the range of evidence that teachers use to inform grades will be consistent across each class or cohort for each qualification.

You should have been provided with a list of the evidence that will be used to determine grades in each subject.

FINAL GRADE



Your teachers will **NOT** be able to tell you the final grades they will be submitting to the exam boards.



There *must* be **NO** negotiation between student/parents and teachers about grades.
