## Year 11 Elevate Education Study Skills



On Wednesday and Thursday our Year 11 Geographers embarked upon Hunstanton for their GCSE fieldwork. The main purpose was to investigate the two key questions for their exam. We investigated how sustainable Hunstanton was, as well as where in Hunstanton had the highest traffic flows. This involved completing three sustainable community assessments to see which area was the most sustainable. They also conducted three traffic flow counts and asked 25 questionnaires each to the public.

On arriving at New Hunstanton, the teachers had great delight in witnessing one group of students try to outsmart each other with what coastal management they could see!

The two groups were a credit to the school. The staff received lots of comments from the public about how well they spoke when conducting their questionnaires as well as how polite they were – well done Year 11!
