Dear Parent / Carer.

I hope this letter finds you well. I apologise that we did not get a letter out to you last week. There has been a huge amount happening in the Academy, some of which is detailed within this letter...



Last week, Miss Scarff took ten boys from Year 8 and 9 to Stanground and Yaxley fire stations to take part in the weeklong Firebreak course. This programme allowed the students to get hands-on experience of being a firefighter; being trained by actively serving firefighters in search and rescue, first aid, and the day-to-day life of a serving fire fighter. The students have taken part in hose running, ladder training, mess duties, education about arson and knife crime and completing drills on the drill ground, as well as entering smoke filled buildings to rescue and resuscitate CPR dummies.

On Friday, the boys successfully 'passed out' in a parade where they showed off their fantastic new drill skills, completing manoeuvres that a senior fire fighter described as worthy of a trainee of six months or more. The boys displayed **fantastic teamwork and communication skills** and watching them pass out was incredibly inspiring. The boys had great support from some of their families, their year teams, senior members of the fire service and even some Peterborough Utd players in the audience to cheer them on!

The students (and Miss Scarff) have all received two AQA qualifications for their participation; one in emergency first aid and one in active citizenship. Hopefully, some of them will go on to have incredible careers in the fire service as well. Well-done to these students and thank you to Miss Scarff for facilitating them to have such a great week.
