Re: Y11 PPE Results, Reports and Parents Evening 4pm – 6.30pm Monday 28th November 2022

Following the recent PPE exam series, we plan to hold a PPE results event on Friday 25th November where all students will receive their exam results just like they will in August 2023 with the real exams.

We will also be providing each student with a detailed report on how they performed in their exams. We would really like them to be able to discuss this with you over the weekend. This document will provide parents and students the most up to date information on progress and attainment broken down into each subject.

To give advice on next steps needed to succeed in their final exams in May/June, we will be running a Parents Evening on Monday 28th November 2022 from 4pm until 6pm, where parents can speak to individual subject staff. This will be run virtually through the School Cloud parents evening booking system. This system allows you to book 5-minute appointments to speak virtually with subject teachers from your phone, tablet or computer.

The system will be open for you to book appointments from 5pm on Monday 14th November 2022.

Please be aware that the nature of any system such as this means any conversation, we have is limited to a 5-minute session. This may mean that it feels more like a one-sided feedback session with the staff member as opposed to a discussion. It may also mean the conversation is cut off abruptly.

If you have questions which you or your son/daughter would like answered – they could jot them down in their planners and direct them in person to the staff member. Alternatively, please feel free to email subject teachers or Mr Hunneyball with more personal queries and they will reply when able.


