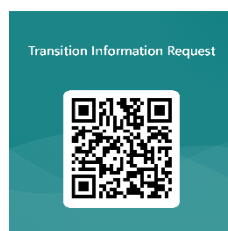
New Year 7 Students Starting in September 2023
