Equipment

It is really important that students arrive at school with the correct equipment. This allows them to access their learning and be well organised for any work or activities that may be happening each day.

Each Year 7 student will need:

- An appropriately sized school bag (to fit an A4 folder)
- A water bottle
- A pencil case containing pens (blue or black), pencils, ruler, eraser, compass, protractor, colouring pencils. **This is provided by the school initially but it is good to have spare items of stationary, especially pens and pencils.**
- Any specific equipment needed for specific lessons e.g. PE kit, cooking ingredients etc.
